Dear Motor Carrier:

Effective June 11, 2015, a revision to the Michigan Movers Association Tariff 4000 requires that all motor carriers of household goods attend a tariff training session within 180 days following the issuance of Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Division authority (formerly MPSC authority). The tariff revision reads as follows:

Page 4, Item 15: MMA Tariff 4000

1. All newly authorized household goods carriers must complete a tariff training session at the Michigan State Police, Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Division, or other training approved by the Michigan Movers Association. Attendance is required within 180 days following the issuance of Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Division authority.
2. Any household goods carrier determined to have violated any provision of the tariff shall complete a tariff training session within 180 days following the finding of the evaluation.
3. The Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Division shall publish the training session schedule in the Motor carrier by-weekly bulletin.
4. Failure to complete the tariff training session as required above will result in sanctions, up to and including the revocation of CVED authority.

In order to meet the requirements for compliance for statewide (over 40 miles) carriers of household goods, the Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Division has scheduled a Tariff Workshop. Please see the attached notification of the workshop details.

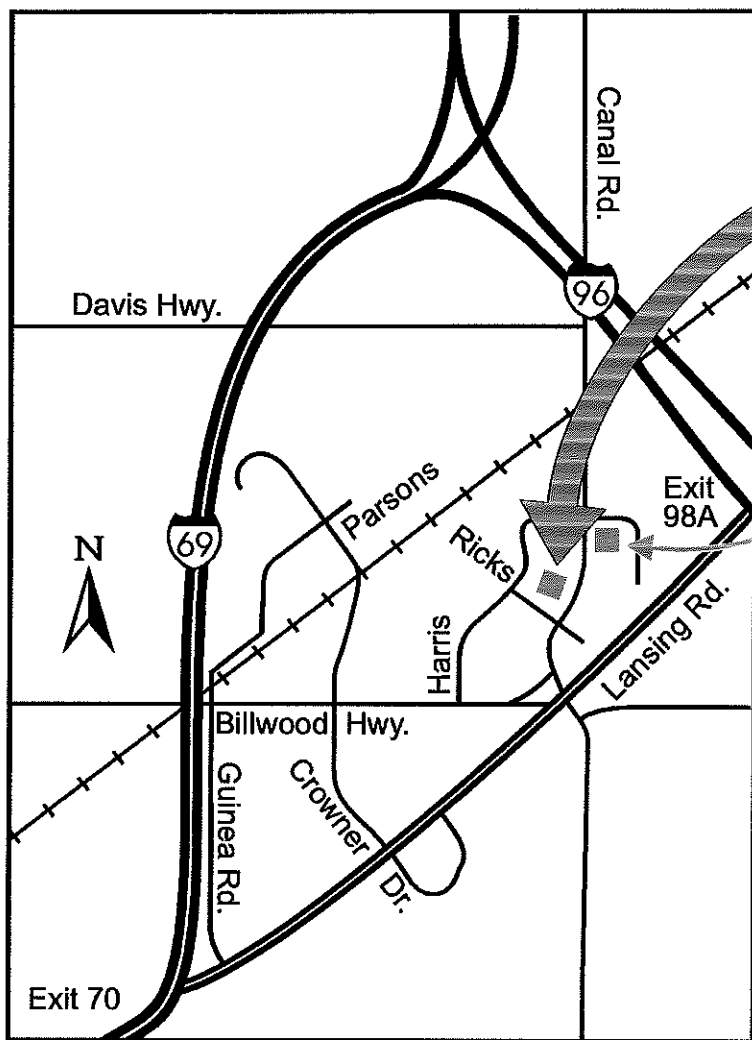

Directions to the Construction Field Services Building

If you're traveling east or west on I-96, take exit 98A, head west on Lansing Road. Canal Road is the first traffic light after the I-96/Lansing Road interchange, turn right onto Canal Road.

If you're traveling north on I-69, take exit 70 and head east on Lansing Road. Canal Road is the second traffic light after the I-69/Lansing Road interchange, turn left onto Canal Road.

Traveling north on Canal Road, Ricks Road is the second road on the left, turn left. The Construction Field Services Building will be on your right. Parking is available in the lot in front of the building.
